**THE SHEEP CLASSES ARE OPEN.** All entries must be submitted on the approved Entry Form by the specified Closing Date and must comply with orders and regulations under Diseases of Animals Acts current at the time of the Show.

Movement documents must be handed in to Stewards at the gate on arrival at the Showground. All sheep must be correctly ear tagged or tattooed in accordance with SEERAD/DEFRA guidelines. As in past years, SEERAD may, without notice, attend this Show to carry out inspections.

**ENTRY WILL BE REFUSED WITHOUT THE CORRECT DOCUMENTATION.**

**NOTE:** Border Leicester, Registered Suffolk, Lley, Texel and Charollais entries must be from fully M.V. ACCREDITED FLOCKS and will be provided with approved penning.

**All other Sections will be in non-accredited accommodation.**

It is recommended that all Sheep should be treated with a licensed product for the control of SHEEP SCAB within 14 days prior to their arrival at the Show.
